PRESS NOTE

1. Electors:

As on 10.09.2026, there are **4,46,58,413** electors in the Electoral Roll, comprising **2,21,69,552** male, **2,24,85,987** female and **2,874** TG electors. District-wise elector details are given in **Annexure-1**.

2. Notices Generation:

As on 10.09.2026, a total of **43,81,760** notices has been generated across the State.

Out of the notices generated, **24,97,075** notices have been successfully delivered, while **18,84,685** notices are yet to be delivered, resulting in an overall delivery percentage of **56.99%**.

With regard to hearings, **7,03,710 (28.18%)** hearings have been completed out of the delivered notices, while **17,93,365** hearings are pending.

Last hearing will be conducted on 12.10.2026 and last date for disposal of Claims and Objections and notice phase is 22.10.2026.

6. Special Campaigns for Registration of Electors:

Second drive of Special campaign for the registration of electors will be conducted on 19.09.2026 and 20.09.2026 as per the ECI instructions.

7. Meeting conducted by the CEO:

A meeting was conducted on 09.09.2026 by the Chief Electoral Officer through video conference with all the District Election Officers and the Electoral Registration Officers to review the progress of voter enrolment. Necessary directions were issued to ensure timely delivery of notices and completion of hearings.

Note: *Several queries have been received regarding electors not finding their names in the same part of the draft electoral roll where they were registered earlier. It is clarified that, due to rationalization of polling stations and re-serialization of electors, the Part Number and Serial Number may have changed. Electors who are unable to find their names in the previous parts are therefore requested to search using their EPIC number on **voters.eci.gov.in** or through the ECINET mobile application.*

Details regarding the period for submission, eligibility (who can apply), application procedure, place of submission, required documents, and the step-by-step process for applying using Form 6 for inclusion of name in the Electoral Roll are provided in **Annexure -4.**

9. Facilitation for Submission of Documents by Authorized Family Members of certain Electors:

A memorandum has been issued on 11.09.2026 to all District Election Officers, directing them to issue necessary instructions to the Electoral Registration Officers (EROs) and Assistant Electoral Registration Officers (AEROs) to permit any adult family member of senior citizens, PwD, sick or overseas electors to appear in person before the ERO/AERO on their behalf and submit the required documents/information for the disposal of notices issued to such electors. A copy of the memorandum is enclosed at **Annexure-5.**

**How to Apply Online Using Form 6 for Inclusion of Name in the Electoral Roll
Step-by-Step Process**

Note regarding submission of Form - 6

- **Period for Submission**

The names of persons who submit Form 6 during the claims and objections period, i.e., from 24th August, 2026 to 23rd September, 2026, will appear in the Final Electoral Rolls to be published on 27.10.2026, after due verification by ERO. Form 6 can be submitted throughout the year.

- **Who Can Apply?**

The following persons who are not enrolled anywhere in India may submit Form 6:

- a. Eligible electors whose names do not appear in the Draft Electoral Roll and who are residing in Karnataka.
- b. Eligible young citizens who have attained or will attain 18 years of age on or before the qualifying date, i.e., 1st October, 2026.

The applicants need to ensure the following:

- He/She is a citizen of India.
- He/She has attained/will attain the age of 18 years as on 01.10.2026
- He/She is an ordinary resident at the address mentioned in the application
- He/She is currently not enrolled as an elector anywhere else in India
- He/She submits supporting document/s notified by the Election Commission alongwith the application

- **How and Where to Apply?**

Applicants may submit a duly filled and signed Form 6 along with the prescribed Declaration Form through any of the following modes:

Online:

- Citizen Service Portal (voters.eci.gov.in)
- ECINET Mobile Application

Offline:

- Office of the concerned Electoral Registration Officer (ERO).
- Booth Level Officer (BLO).

- **Documents Required**

Applicants should keep the following documents ready:

- Proof of Age
- Proof of Ordinary Residence (Address Proof)
- Recent colour passport-size photograph
- Details relating to the last Special Intensive Revision (SIR) for filling the Declaration Form
- If the applicant does not possess the details of the last SIR, the alternative documents prescribed in the Declaration Form shall be produced during verification.

a. Step-by-Step Process for applying form 6 online for Inclusion of Name in the Electoral Roll

Step 1:

Keep the Required Documents Ready

Before starting the application, keep the above-mentioned documents ready in digital format:

Step 2:

- Visit the Voters' Portal or Open the ECINET App
- Visit the Voters' Portal: voters.eci.gov.in
- Or open the ECINET Mobile App. The portal provides a dedicated option for New Voter Registration (Form 6) and the accompanying Declaration Form.

Step 3:

Log In

- Log in using your registered mobile number and OTP.
- If you are a new user, create an account using your mobile number and basic details.

Step 4:

Click on “Voter Registration Forms” and Select “New Voter Registration (Form 6)”

Step 5:

Fill Form 6

Enter all the required particulars carefully, including:

- Personal details
- Date of Birth
- Gender
- Mobile Number and Email ID (if available)
- Complete residential address
- Family/EPIC details, wherever applicable

Step 6:

Fill the Declaration Form

Complete the prescribed Declaration Form by providing the required details relating to the last Special Intensive Revision (SIR), wherever applicable.

Step 7:

Upload Supporting Documents

Upload scanned copies of:

Proof of Age

Proof of Address

Recent colour photograph

Any other documents required under the Declaration Form, if applicable

Step 8:

Review the Application

Carefully verify all the information entered. Ensure that:

All mandatory fields are filled

Documents are legible

The information matches the uploaded documents

Step 9:

Submit the Application

Click “Submit” to complete the online application.

Step 10:**Note the Reference Number**

After successful submission, a unique Reference/Application Number will be generated. Save or download the acknowledgement for future reference.

Step 11:**Verification by Election Officials**

The application and documents will be verified by the Booth Level Officer (BLO) and the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO). If additional information or documents are required, the applicant may be contacted.

Step 12:**Track Application Status**

Applicants can track the status of their application online using the Reference/Application Number through the Voters' Portal or the ECINET App.

b. Step-by-Step Process for applying form 6 offline for Inclusion of Name in the Electoral Roll**Step 1:**

Collect physical form 6 from the office of ERO/AERO or from the BLO. Form 6 can also be downloaded from the website of CEO, Karnataka (<https://ceo.karnataka.gov.in/downloadForms.html>)

Step 2:

Fill the details of the applicant in the Form 6

Step 3:

Attach one color passport size photograph in the prescribed box.

Step 4:

Fill the declaration form with details of electoral roll of the last SIR. The applicant needs to fill his/her last SIR details. If not available, the applicant can fill the details of last SIR details of his/her parents or grand parents.

Step 5:

The applicant needs to sign the form 6 and also the declaration form.

Step 6:

The applicant needs to attach documents prescribed above.

Step 7:

The applicant needs to hand over the filled form along with declaration form and documents to the BLO or the offices of ERO/AERO

Step 8:

The applicant needs to collect the acknowledgment for record purposes.

**GUIDELINES FOR FILLING UP THE APPLICATION
FORM-6A**

Who can file Form-6A

1. Every Indian citizen staying in a foreign country, who has not acquired citizenship of a foreign country, and has completed 18 years as on 1st January of the year, can make an application in Form 6A for being registered in the roll for the constituency pertaining to the locality in which his place of residence in India as mentioned in the passport is located. The application in Form 6A can be presented to the registration officer concerned.
2. The applicant should have completed eighteen years of age as on 1st January of the year. For example, if the application is for inclusion of name in the electoral roll with reference to 01-01-2017 as the qualifying date, the applicant should have completed 18 years as on 01-01-2017.

Availability of Form 6A

Form will be available at EROs/AEROs Office/Designated Locations/Authorized Centres. It can also be downloaded from NVSP portal i.e, <http://www.nvsp.in/> or from the ECI website, i.e, <http://eci.nic.in>.

Where to submit the application in Form-6A

The application should be submitted directly to the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO) of the constituency within which the place of ordinary residence of the applicant as given in the valid passport falls. The Application in Form 6A can be presented in person to the ERO or sent by post addressed to the ERO concerned. The application can also be filed online on the National Voter Service Portal (NVSP) of the Election Commission, i.e, <http://www.nvsp.in/> or on the website of Chief Electoral Officer of the State concerned (Link of CEOs' website has been provided on the Commission's website, i.e, http://eci.nic.in/eci_main1/Links.aspx).

6. If the application is submitted in person before the ERO, the application should be accompanied by a photo-copy of the relevant pages of the passport as mentioned above. The original passport should also be produced alongwith the application for verification by the registration officer. The passport will be returned immediately after verification.

7. It may be noted that after enrolment of the name of the Applicant, he will be able to cast vote in election in the constituency, if he is physically present in the polling station along with his original passport on the day of poll.
